
Directions - For Long Lake Park

- 35W from the South: Exit at West County Road E2 (26). Head West then turn right on 5th Ave NW. Continue onto 0ld Hwy 8.
- 35W from the North: Take 694 West
- From 694: Exit on Long Lake Road (40). Turn south and follow 10th St NW to Old Hwy 8. Travel north on Old Hwy 8 to the park entrance.
- At the park entrance, travel past the railroad tracks then turn right. We'll be in or around the parking lot.


There are bathrooms but no power hook ups. There are many trees and open areas or for antenna placement, along with open areas available to set up a table.
